SUMMARY OF LCSD #7 INTEGRATED PEST MANAGEMENT PLAN

1. The district is restricted on where, how and when pesticides may be applied. There are two separate programs but both are jointly integrated in determining how pesticides are used or not used.
 - A. Integrated Pest Management (IPM): This program is required as the first step in determining whether or not the use of chemical pesticides are warranted. This program requires that non-chemical pest control should be used before a chemical pesticide is applied.
 - Staff should use the Pest Log to report pest problems. Return the form to the district office on a periodic basis.
 - B. Pesticide Application Program: This program regulates the use of pesticides and the licensing and certification of pesticide applicators. Essentially, the use of chemical pesticides are considered the last step in pest control.
 1. Licensed maintenance personnel may apply chemical pesticides on school grounds only if they are licensed and certified to apply the pesticide used.
 2. The type of pesticides used should be the least toxic and have a “Caution” label.
 3. Pesticides with “Warning” and “Danger” labels may be used in some cases.
 4. Prior approval must be obtained prior to the application of any pesticides. A pesticide application plan and application record must be completed.
